Race Day volunteer registration procedures:

Please be on-site by 6:30AM unless otherwise specified. All volunteers are required to sign in with Volunteer Coordinator at the motor home. Meet your crew chief at the motor home for last minute instructions and to pick up your equipment. If your position requires a radio, you will be assigned one at that time and shown how to use it. Volunteers and Positions

Volunteer Position	Duties	Location and Equipment required
<u>Course Set-up Trail Vehicle</u>	Position the turnaround markers and caution signs as per course map Patrol the course to pick up DNF cyclists, and to ensure all cyclists have cleared the course Communicate with Race Director, Turnaround Control and Transition Crew Chief as required	Bike Course Polyposts & cones "Race in Progress" signs Van, truck or station wagon RADIO CELLPHONE (if possible)
<u>Motorcycle</u>	Transport bike official on the course	Bike course
<u>Parking Lot Control</u>	Direct all vehicles into east parking lot (farthest lot from transition) Stop vehicles as needed to ensure cyclist safety Explain to drivers what's going on and where they can park (if asked)	East Beach Road – East Parking Lot entrance Safety vest Stop sign
<u>Crash Corner Control</u>	Ensure the safety of outbound and inbound cyclists by stopping and directing vehicle traffic. Explain to drivers what's going on and where they can park (if asked) Communicate with Race Director and Crew Chief as required	Crash Corner RADIO Safety vests Stop signs
<u>Lap Control</u>	Direct lapping cyclists to keep left to the turnaround point Direct finishing cyclists to keep right Ensure the safety of lapping and finishing cyclists by stopping and directing vehicle traffic.	Lap/Finish Turnaround (on South Road just before Crash Corner) Safety vests & Stop signs
<u>Campground Control</u>		Campground Entrance

	Ensure the safety of cyclists by stopping and directing vehicle traffic exiting the campground.	Safety vests & Stop signs (bring your lawn chair)
<u>Turnaround Control</u>	Ensure the safety of turning cyclists by stopping and directing vehicle traffic. Communicate with Race Director and Crew Chief as required	Far end of bike course on South Road Safety vests & Stop signs Safety vests & Stop signs RADIO
<u>Lap Counters</u>	Record the laps done by each cyclist (TryATri – 1, Sprint – 2, Olympic – 4)	Far end of bike course on South Road Clipboard, pens, start lists (bring your lawn chair)
<u>Spotter</u>	Assist lap counters by calling race numbers	Far end of bike course on South Road
