Volunteers and Positions

Volunteer Position	Duties	Location and Equipment required
<u>Course Set-up</u>	(Sat evening) Position the turnaround & sighting buoys to give the required course length	Swim course Yellow & orange buoys Laser range finder Cinder blocks Polyposts & tape for corral Green carpet for transition path Canoe for hauling buoys
<u>Starter</u>	Swim Start Time: 8:00AM Coordinate with swim and du timers to start each event Sound the start	Swim course Megaphone RADIO
<u>Swim check in and out</u>	Check in time: 15 min before start Corral swimmers 15 minutes before each event. Check swimmers into the water by event and race number. Count the number of swimmers exiting the water, plus DNFs, at the end of each event. Confirm number with Starter & Lifeguards to ensure all swimmers are accounted for.	Swim course Start list for each event Clipboard Pens
<u>Lifeguards</u> 3 from Emergency Rescue Response Services (ERRS)	On-Site from 7:30 – 10:30AM	On the swim course Lifesaving aids RADIOS - 3
<u>Watercraft</u> 2 kayak from ERRS	Transport the lifeguards and patrol the swim course. Provide assistance to swimmers in need	Near the start, middle and far end of the course
