Race Day volunteer registration procedures:

Please be on-site by 6:30AM unless otherwise specified. All volunteers are required to sign in with Volunteer Coordinator at the motor home. Meet your crew chief at the motor home for last minute instructions and to pick up your equipment. If your position requires a radio, you will be assigned one at that time and shown how to use it. Volunteer Position	Duties	Location and Equipment required
<u>Announcer</u>	Start Time: 6:30AM Make announcements as requested by Race Director and Officials. Announce athletes as they cross finish line (if possible) Communicate with Race Director and Crew Chiefs as required	Near finish line. TriMB sound system RADIO
<u>Registration</u>	Start time: 5:50AM Check in pre-registered athletes Register race day entries Provide timing band & numbered swim cap to each entry Give race towels if purchased Print start list for swim start, bike/run lap counters, announcer	Motorhome Race computer & printer Pens & clipboards Cashbox & float Timing boards & bands Box of race towels Swim caps & black markers
<u>Body Markers</u>	Start time: 5:50AM Mark race number on both arms and legs using black waterproof marker. Need to mark both so number is visible to officials and lap counters.	Beside Motorhome Black markers
<u>Timing, Tags & Boards</u>	Exact duties and location on course to be assigned by chief timer. May include operating stop watch, grabbing timing tags and/or holding tag boards. Chief Timer to communicate with Race Director and Crew Chiefs as required.	Near swim finish, near run start, near finish line Stop watches Pens Tag boards RADIO – Chief Timer
