<u>Transition Build - Friday</u>	Pick up truck Pick up trailer & equipment from TriMB storage site in Stonewall Set up transition snow fence Set up bike racks for KOS Chalk transition markings for mount & dismount Mark bike racks Put up transition signage Set up KOS swim course	Snow fence & posts, mallet, racks, signage, zip ties, chalk, swim buoys, shop vac to inflate buoys, rope, cinder blocks, canoe to help position buoys
<u>Set up - Saturday</u>	Set up bike chutes on the asphalt Set up swim corral Set up finish line signage Set up sound system & race clock Set up medical tent Set up food tent	Transition Polyposts, pylons, flagging, chalk, signs, finish line sign & poles, sandbags, generator, gas, sound system, race clock Tents & picnic tables
<u>Security before start</u>	Keep spectators out of transition – competitors only.	Bike exit & entrance chutes (Swim & Run exits should be closed prior to start)
<u>Bike Mount Line</u>	Direct athletes to mount line	Bike Mount Line
<u>Bike Dismount Line</u>	Direct athletes to dismount line	Bike Dismount Line
<u>Swim & Run Exits</u>	Direct athletes to appropriate exit if necessary	RADIO – Crew Chief
